Bring your family to enjoy the soulful sounds of DJ ShiShi, with Kenny the Clown, yoyo classes, food trucks by Humphry Slocombe, Los Bayuncos, Tokachi Musubi and free hot chocolate by Savor. Sunday is free community day at SFMOMA across the street.
